The Great Annual Migration

Experience has taught us that, the Great Migration tops every list of East Africa safari visitor. Some call it the spectacle; others, the seventh new world wonder, the Annual Wildebeest Migration, and we, at Wemar Safaris call it the Annual Wildebeest Ritual! Whatever the name, the Great Annual Wildebeest Migration is inspiring site that you cannot afford to miss that happens yearly. The largest and longest overland migration in the world, nowhere has there been such a large movement of wild animals other than Kenya and Tanzania. One of the must do list when visiting East Africa!

The show is anchored on Mara and Serengeti Ecosystem. What this means is that, the wildebeests do not require visa nor passport to access the two for their movement is never restricted. With a landmass of 40,000km², 1.8million wildebeest, over 400,000 Thompson gazelles, 30,000 zebras and antelopes and hundreds of predators setting out on a long trek from Tanzania Parks to Kenya's Maasai Mara in search of greener pastures and water. It's a cycle that never ends and repeats every year. However, their migration is never complete without some misfortunes befalling them. In fact, a spectacular sight is when they have to cross the Grumeti River in northern Serengeti and the crocodile infested Mara River. As predators such as lions, leopards, cheetahs and hyenas accompany them to capitalize on the weak and the young, crocodiles lie in wait with anticipation for the big kill for those who can't cope with the strong water currents.

The Migration Cycle

JAN – MAR: Animals converge at Ndutu region because of the short green grass and water in Lake Ndutu as they move towards Ngorongoro Conservation Area. This is the calving season and females drop their young ones mostly in the third week of arrival due to assurance of security of short grass without the fear of predators lurking in taller grass. Approximately half a million calves are born during this season.

Where to stay: Ndutu Safari Lodge, Lemala Ndutu Camp, Kusini Camp.

APR –JUNE: The long rains have started, and the rivers are swelling and most of the grass in the southern parts of Serengeti is gone, the wildebeests start moving northwards of Serengeti and individual groups begin to congregate and form much larger herds in readiness for the long trek.

Where to stay: Grumeti River Camp, Migration Camp, Serengeti Serena, Kirawira Camp, Moru & Seronera Campsites.

JULY: The animals have dispensed with the first three hurdles, and now, they must overcome the last one: the crocodile infested Mara River which is a converging point is by this time also flooded and drowning is a very big possibility. It's the best time.

Where to stay: Mara Serena Safari Lodge, Sayari Camp, Kichwa Tembo, Bataleur Camps.

AUG – OCT: The Mara is full and overflowing with large herds of wildebeest together with the predators. Where to stay: Governors Camp, Mara Intrepids Camp, Sarova Mara Tented Camp, Mara Serena Safari lodge.

NOV – DEC: The short rains have started and our visitors, the wildebeests begin to move to the now lush grasses in Ndutu and Selei plains in Serengeti, crossing the Mara and Grumeti Rivers once again back to Tanzania as the cycle begins all over again.

Where to stay: Klein's Camp.

Great Wildebeest Migration Facts





- 1. It's estimated that about ¼ million wildebeests die during migration from Serengeti to Mara and back mainly due to exhaustion or predation otherwise, their population would have spiraled out of control and exerted pressure on the ecosystem bringing about human/wildlife conflict.
- 2. Wildebeest have a gestation period of 8-9 months.
- 3. Wildebeest are also called Gnu because of the sound they produce during migration, "gnu", "gnu".
- 4. ½ million calves are born during the February and March and the newborns can be running after just 3 minutes.



KENYATTA INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE CENTRE (KICC)



KICC as it is commonly referred to, is centrally located in Nairobi CBD and it neighbors City Hall & Holy Family Basilica to the North, Foreign Affairs building, Office of the President, and AGs chambers to the South, The Supreme Court & Jogoo House to the East and Kenyatta Mausoleum and the Kenyan Parliament to the West.

The iconic building, standing 105 meters high was built between 1966 and 1973. During the design, World Bank decided that it would host its 1973 Annual Meeting in Nairobi, and the building was chosen as the venue prompting an extension in size with an addition of a magnificent auditorium.

KICC has an amphitheater with a capacity of 800 and a plenary hall that can accommodate 4,000 people and conference halls of different sizes ideal for business meetings and security is perfect, with a police station at the basement of the building.

It's a world class venue which offers advanced meeting rooms, VIP rooms, & parking facilities. Its propinquity to various 5-star hotels within the city makes it stand out among the best and it's a first choice for many organizers both from Africa and Abroad. The building has a revolving restaurant at the rooftop which runs on a motor mechanism that revolves a complete 360° turn in 76 minutes.

The Julius Nyerere International Convention Centre (JNICC) is a branch of AICC build in Dar es Saalam city with sophisticated audio-video communication, and information technology.

In Tanzania, Arusha International Conference Centre (AICC) lies at the heart of Arusha city, a stone throw away from Mt. Kilimanjaro, and it's near the stunning wildlife of Ngorongoro Crater, Serengeti, Tarangire and Manyara.

AICC has its all major rooms fitted with modern conference equipments such as Simultaneous Interpretation System (SIS), multimedia (LCD) projectors, and other audio visuals.



Balloon Safaris in Kenya & Tanzania


Balloon Safaris are the most evocative and romantic way of seeing the wilderness of Africa, as you silently and gracefully fly over the plains crowded with herds or group of wild life in the beautiful early morning. Typically, a Balloon Safari begins at around 6 in the morning and lasts for about one hour. During this period you will likely see the magnificent wildlife below and over several square kilometers of the best game parks in Africa.

In the morning of your Balloon Safari trip, the Safari vehicle will pick you from your camp or lodge as early as 5.a.m. to drive you to the site arriving at around 6.a.m. Here, you have a chance to watch the pilots preparing the Balloons for a take-off while enjoying your cup of traditional Kenyan fresh tea or coffee The Masai Mara lodge breakfast is set up on poetic savannah plains of the Mara, mostly under a single acacia tree shade. You will be served with waiters/ waitresses in traditional Kenyan attires with a breakfast complete with eggs to order, fresh juices, coffee, and champagne name them Masai Mara Balloon Safari gives a lifetime experience that you will forever live to cherish.


Balloon Safari in Amboseli

Balloon Safari in Serengeti



Serengeti is the only place which holds Balloon Safaris regularly and they take off in the Seronera area where there is no animal disturbance. The Safari vehicle will drop you off at the take off site and pick you up from the landing site.

At the Serengeti launch site you will meet your pilot who will give you instructions and precautions to take during the Balloon Safari flight.

The pilot increases more heat into the Balloon from time to time using the powerful whisper burners.

After landing you can celebrate with a Champaign before sitting down to an English breakfast which will be served in the bush.

When & Where To Go On An African Safari

When to go on a safari sometimes depends on when you can actually take a vacation. If you're looking for the best safari experience and don't mind what country to go to, then this is the right guide just for you. It's a month by month blow account of the best animal viewing opportunities in Africa.

January

January is prime safari time in Kenya, Tanzania and Uganda. The weather is usually dry and the animals will congregate in dense numbers around permanent water supplies.

The migrating wildebeest can be found in northern parks of Tanzania during this time of year especially in the southern Ndutu and Salei plains.

February

February is one of the best months to go on safari in Tanzania because thousands of wildebeest are usually born around this time. Most of the wildebeest give birth within the same three week period. If you like seeing young animals, Kenya, Tanzania and Uganda are all perfect this time of year.

March

Kenya, Tanzania and Uganda are still in dry season and the density and diversity of animals can't be matched elsewhere this month.

April

It's a good month for those looking for discounted safaris because the rains usually start in East Africa. Rains bring plentiful water and the animals tend to disperse making them harder to find while on safari. Vegetation begins to get very lush which can obstruct your views of the animals. It's an ideal safari in Tanzania without the crowds, especially in the northern parks. Southern Africa is coming in to its own, in April with cooler, drier weather and Botswana and Namibia are good places for April.

May

The best country to go on safari is probably Zambia. Zambia offers a truly wild African safari and there aren't too many months when the parks can operate at full tilt, so you have to take advantage of it while it lasts.

If you have your heart set on an East African safari, you'll still see a lot of animals, especially in Tanzania even though it's leafy. Make sure the camps and lodges you wish to go to are open. You should be able to get some nice discounts.

June

Southern Africa countries are heading into their best safari period by June. South Africa, Botswana, Zambia, Zimbabwe and Namibia enjoy their high season this time of year. Be prepared for some chilly nights and bring a jacket for the early morning drives and walks.

July - September

Every major safari destination is primed for business in East Africa. Kenya's Masai Mara lays out the green carpet for millions of migrating wildebeest and a welcoming red carpet for tourists. This is the time for those spectacular river crossings with the crocodiles lying in wait for feeble wildebeest to stumble into their salivating jaws.

Parks can get crowded and booked up well in advance and so if you're looking for a budget safari, try a different season because this, is the season of the seventh world wonder- *The Great Wildebeest Migration!*

October

Kenya and Tanzania are the best places for a safari in October. The small rainy season has usually not arrived yet and the dry months make game viewing very rewarding.

November

Tanzania's northern parks are the best places to go on safari in November, as the migrating herds make their way back to Serengeti.

If you're a fun of birds, Botswana's Okavango Delta begins to fill up with migrating birds, starting their breeding season that lasts until March.

December

East Africa reigns once more as the best safari destination and if you'd like to spend Christmas in the bush, then Kenya, Tanzania and Uganda enjoy some dry weather and excellent game viewing.



Day 1: Nairobi/Aberdare

Nairobi, the famous green city in the sun, the capital of Kenya,is located in the highlands southern part of the country. We leave Nairobi early morning and drive to Aberdare National Park arriving at Ark Lodge in good time for lunch and then head go for an afternoon game drive till evening.

'The Majestic Moorland' as is popularly known is home to the second largest herd of endangered black rhino. There are over 250 species of birds that include goshawks, eagles, sparrow hawks, and sunbirds.



Day 2: Aberdare/Samburu

After breakfast, we depart to Samburu Game Reserve. Samburu Game Reserve stands as one of the most beautiful Kenya Parks in Northern Circuit and it encompasses Shaba, Samburu, and Buffalo Springs, forming parks only separated by Ewaso Nyiro River. Samburu Game Reserve is situated in the rugged hot semi-arid lowlands of the vast Northern Frontier District 350km away from Nairobi, covering 165 sq. km of land.

Dinner and accommodation will be at the Ashnil Samburu Camp. Meal Plan: {B, L, D}

Best Time to Visit June to September and January to February High Season December to March and July to October (Busy) Best Weather June and December (Cool and fresh after rain)

Day 4: Samburu/Lake Nakuru

After breakfast, we depart to Lake Nakuru National Park. The park was gazetted as a bird sanctuary in 1960 before elevating it to a national park in1968 and covers an area of 118km². One third of the park is covered by the lake and it is surrounded by wooded & bushy grassland lying on the floor of the Great Rift Valley.

Day 3: Samburu

The whole day will be spent exploring this amazing game reserve; with occasional breaks for breakfast and lunch. The park gives you the refreshment of your mind as the park is not populated and not many people visits here. Its home to the big five, Elephant, Lion, Rhino, Leopard, and Buffalo, also Gerenuk, Reticulated Giraffe, Somali Ostrich, Gravy Zebra, Besia Oryx, Endangered Wild Dog as well as Pun cake Tortoise. There are over 450 species of birds identified and aquatic species in the Waso Nyiro River including, vultures, kingfishers, marabous, bateleurs, guinea fowl, Somali ostriches and others.

Dinner and accommodation will be at the Ashnil Samburu Camp. Meal Plan: {B, L, D}

Day 6: Masai Mara

After breakfast we have a full day dame drive, with packed lunch provided. The reserve is well known for its resident wildlife and its one of the few places where it's possible to see the big five during a morning's game drive. For the bird enthusiast, over 450 species have been recorded: among these 16 species of eagle, plus many hawks and falcons, 6 species of vultures, 8 species of storks 4 of bustard (including the Kori bustard, the world's heaviest flying bird), and 9 species of sun birds.

Dinner and accommodation will be at the Ilkeliani Camp Tented Camp.

Meal Plan: {B, L, D}

Day 5: Lake Nakuru/Masai Mara

We arrive here in time for lunch then go for an afternoon game drive in the reserve which offers breathtaking views with extraordinary density of animals including the "Big Five".

Dinner and accommodation will be at the Ilkeliani Camp Tented Camp. Meal Plan: {B, L, D}



A 4 day safari that will take you to Masai Mara and Lake Nakuru. The Masai Mara Game Reserve is one of the best places in Africa for wildlife viewing and game drives take place all year round. If the big cats are what you're looking for on your Kenyan safari, you are guaranteed to spot them at the Mara. Lake Nakuru is a rhino sanctuary, harboring a cumulative population of over 100 black and white rhinos not forgetting its pink flamingoes.

Day 1: Nairobi/Lake Nakuru

We arrive here in time for lunch before proceeding for an afternoon game drive.

Dinner and accommodation will be at the Entim Camp.

Day 3: Masai Mara



5-Day Mt Kenya, L Nakuru, & Masai Mara Adventure

A safari that combines bird watching at the Great Rift Valley lakes and wildlife safari in Maasai Mara enjoy the tranquil and maximum game-sightings at Mt Kenya and Lake Nakuru. This is a special safari with minimal driving distances hence its ideal for families of all ages.

Day 1: Nairobi - Mt Kenya National Park

We will pick you from your hotel and drive through the industrial town of Thika in Central Kenya to arrive at Serena Mountain Lodge in time for lunch.

The Lodge is located at 2,134 meters above sea level, on the lower slopes of the mountain. The open-air viewing-deck looks down on to its own water hole and salt-lick, which attracts numerous herds of elephant and buffalo. There is also a tunnel leading to a photo-hide, which offers photographic opportunities just meters away from the wildlife at the water hole. Dinner and overnight stay at the Serena Mountain Lodge. Meal Plan: {L, D}

Day 2: Mt Kenya /L. Nakuru National Park

Meal Plan: {B, L, D}

Depart Serena Mountain Lodge soon after breakfast and drive to Lake Nakuru National park. Lunch at Flamingo Hill Luxury Tented Camp followed by a full afternoon game drives at the Kenya's Park famed by its numerous species of birdlife; its flamingo's and the over 400 species of birds found here. The lake itself is a soda lake on the floor of the rift valley. Endangered species- particularly the Rothschild Giraffe and the black and white rhino can be found here. Lions, waterbuck, buffalo and baboons are all residents. Dinner and overnight stay at the Flamingo Hill Luxury Camp. Best Time to Visit June to March best for wildlife viewing High Season July to March Best Weather June to March

Day 3: Lake Nakuru National Park/Masai Mara

Immediately after breakfast, we drive via the Great Rift Valley to arrive at Maasai Mara in time for lunch at Mara Sopa Lodge. Set in the Oloolaimutia valley, the lodge blends in perfectly with its surrounding hillside landscape. 



The sea of grass provides little cover and the young are easy pickings for a variety of predators. Wildebeest calves can run minutes after they are born and within 3 days they are normally strong enough to keep up with the herd. Lunch, Dinner and overnight at Ndutu Safari Lodge. Meal Plan: {B, L, D}

Day 5: Ndutu-Serengeti

Serengeti National Park is easily Tanzania's most famous national park, and it's also the largest, at 14,763 square kilometers of protected area that borders Kenya's Masai Mara Game Park. Its far-reaching plains of endless grass and large stone kopjes are home to rich ecosystems, and the sheer magnitude and scale of life that the plains support is staggering. Enjoy your en route game drive to Serengeti National Park. Dinner and overnight at Tortilis Camp.
